Presentation

Young Talent Architecture Award (YTAA) was launched for the first time in 2016 open to all European architecture schools. In 2018, schools from China and South Korea, as guest countries, were invited to participate. In 2020, for the first time, an independent edition is organised with the four Strategic Partners of the European Union in Asia: China, India, Japan and South Korea aiming to promote exchange and cooperation with their YTAA counterparts in Europe and in the 2020 guest countries: Brazil, Chile and Mexico.

By identifying and supporting the best young talents from Europe and Asia and bringing them together in this exhibition, YTAA facilitates intercultural dialogue and offers cooperation opportunities among professionals, universities, institutions and other relevant partners in the architecture sector. YTAA encourages exchange between Schools and seeks to improve the skills of architects from the beginning of their professional careers while also learning about the differences and similarities in the teaching of architecture worldwide.

YTAA, part of the European Union Prize for Contemporary Architecture – Mies van der Rohe Award, is organised by the Fundació Mies van der Rohe with the support of the Creative Europe programme of the European Union. It is organised in partnership with the European Association for Architectural Education (EAAE) and the Architects' Council of Europe (ACE-CAE); World Architects as a founding partner; the European Cultural Centre as a partner in Venice; sponsored by Jung, Jansen and Regent; and with the support of USM.

Exhibition

This exhibition is prepared to be presented in architecture schools and institutions with the aim to discover how architecture studies are being carried forward and to open the debate on how architecture is taught. It also aims to raise awareness of the Award itself, illustrating how it works and what its values are.

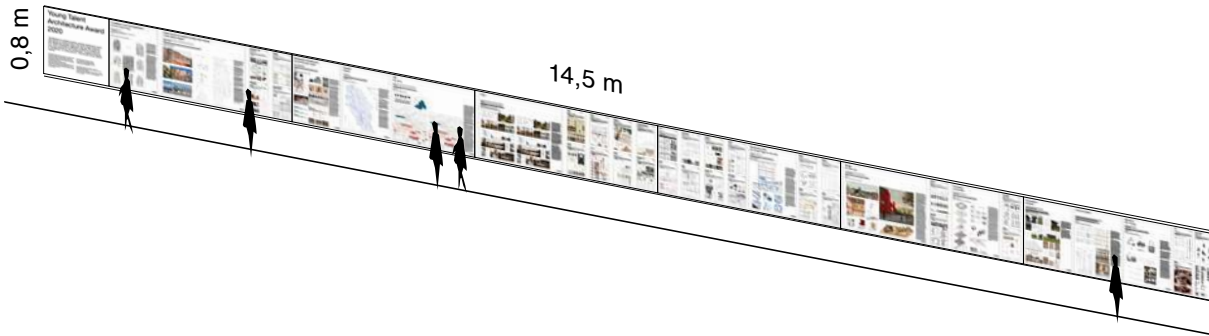
There are 3 versions of the exhibition regarding the Europe and the Asia edition: the first version contains the winner, finalist and shortlisted projects of the Europe edition; the second version showcases the winner, finalist and shortlisted projects of the Asia edition; the third one shows together the winner and the finalist projects of both the Europe and Asia editions.

The format of the three versions have been thought as a self printing continuous paper band of 842mm.

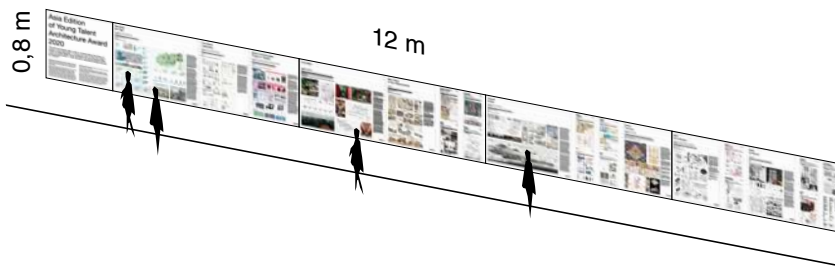
This version contains the group of 43 selected projects by the jury members of the Young Talent Architecture Award 2020.

Asia Edition of Young Talent Architecture Award 2020

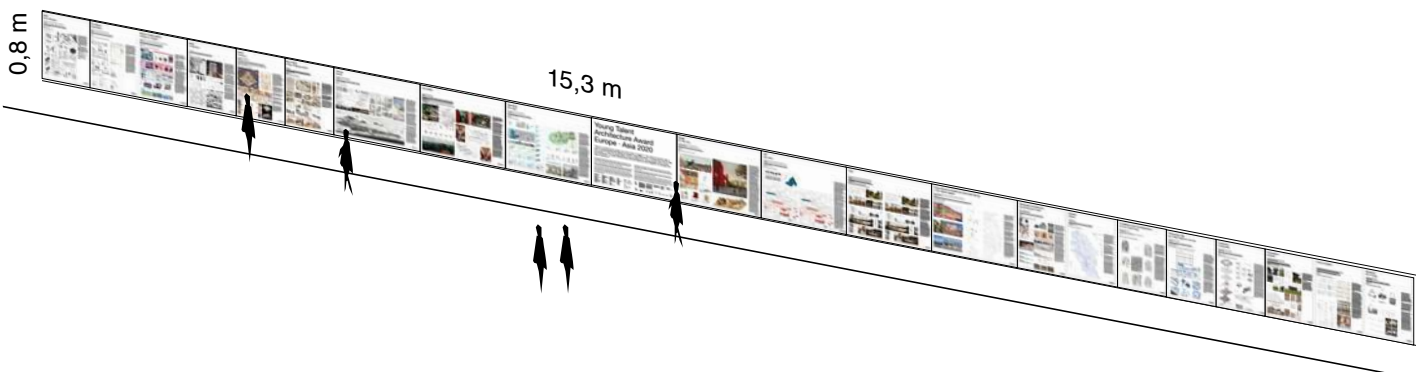
This version contains the group of 22 selected projects by the jury members of the Asia Edition of Young Talent Architecture Award 2020.

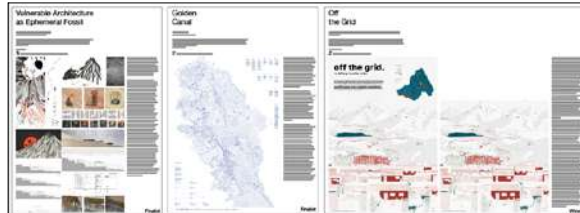
